Please consider homing a "middle aged" dog

Bear in mind that Labrador Retrievers have a life span of 12- 14 years. An 8 or 9 year old Labrador is not an ancient dog. It would still have a good 4 – 5 years, if exercised and fed correctly.

Also, an older dog has done its 'gardening' days, has stopped chewing – hopefully -, has matured, is not as boisterous as a puppy and is possibly a better choice for very young children as it has patience and will not knock littlies flying or nip while playing.

Most dogs this age have had some sort of training so are also a lot more controllable.

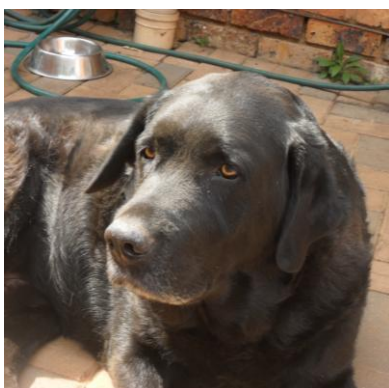

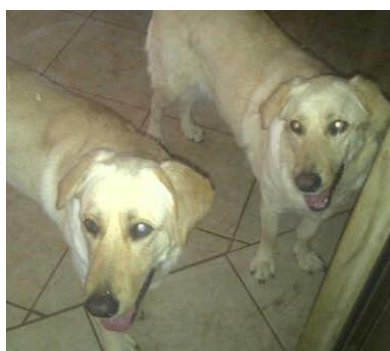


NAME: MILO (CENTURION)

NAME: PUPPIES (JOHANNESBURG)

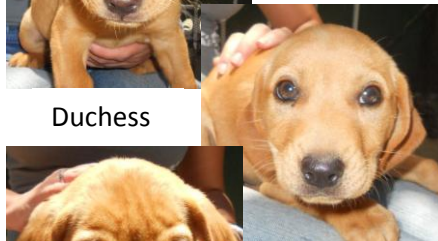

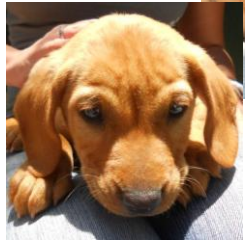
